## **New student groups to gain access to FSHS Seinäjoki services**

**Students at the Seinäjoki University of Applied Sciences in Ähtäri, Ilmajoki, Kurikka and Kauhajoki have been able to gain access to FSHS services from the beginning of 2012. Access to the services was previously restricted to those students who study in Seinäjoki.**

Now all students at the Seinäjoki University of Applied Sciences have an equal opportunity to use the services provided by the FSHS Seinäjoki health centre as well as the other FSHS health centres.

Students can use FSHS services if they are undergraduate students at the Seinäjoki University of Applied Sciences, have paid the FSHS health care fee and their place of study has entered into an agreement with the FSHS.

The health care fee for spring 2012 is €21 and, to gain access to the services, students must pay the fee by 15 February 2012.
