HIGHLIGHTS IN THE HISTORY OF THE FSHS

1932

Student lung checks by the Finnish Anti-Tuberculosis Association began in Helsinki.

1954

The current Finnish Student Health Service (FSHS) was created when the operations of the student health care office of the National Union of University Students were expanded from Helsinki to a nationwide service.

The deed of foundation was signed on 13 February 1954.



1966

The Social Insurance Institution of Finland (Kela) began to provide the FSHS with cofunding.



1988

Municipalities became co-funders of the FSHS and appointed their representatives in the health care station Boards of Directors.



1990

The number of students exceeded 100 000.

2011 - 2013

Municipal agreements permitting pilot testing of the FSHS model at universities of applied sciences were signed in 2011 in Lappeenranta and Seinäjoki. In 2013, pilot testing of the FSHS model at universities of applied sciences was extended to Imatra.
